Video categories:

- News Package (1:00-4:00 Minutes)
- Sports Package (1:00-4:00 Minutes)
- Feature Package (1:00-4:00 Minutes)
- Dramatic Short Film (10 min max)
- Comedic Short Film (10 min max)
- Documentary (no max)
- PSA/Advertisement (1 minute max)

Entry requirements:

Schools must enter two videos in a category to compete in that category and the two videos in the category will be judged together to decide each place. Schools may enter up to four categories in the contest. Individual students may only enter one video as the director in a category. Students may be on multiple crews. Videos that are made outside the school's program (such as workshops and outside courses) are ineligible. The videos eligible for competition must have been produced after May 1, 2020 and students must have been enrolled in a video or photo program at the school during the 2020-2021 school year. All videos must be hosted on a publicly-accessible website and submitted through the ATPI contest system.

Prizes:

Each category will have a first, second, third place and honorable mention winner. Judges will name one overall winner as Top Video Program based on four points for first place, three points for second place, two points for third place and one point for honorable mention. A tie-breaker system will select one Top Video Program if two or more schools tie. The winning program will receive a plaque noting their accomplishment at the next year's Winter Conference.
