- ◆ All images must have been taken or created after Aug. 1, 2025. Work entered in any previous ATPI contest is not eligible for this contest.
- ◆ Instructions for preparing images can be found at www.atpi.org/submission. Entries must contain proper metadata and be uploaded to contest.atpi.org by 6 pm on Thursday, Feb 12, 2026.
- ◆ All student entries must have been created by the student in the photograph. All instructor entries must have been created by the instructor in the photograph.
- ◆ A copy of the fees form from the contest site along with the entry fee should be mailed to ATPI, PO Box 157, Cedar Park, TX 78630. ATPI members pay 50 cents per entry and non-members pay \$1 per entry.
